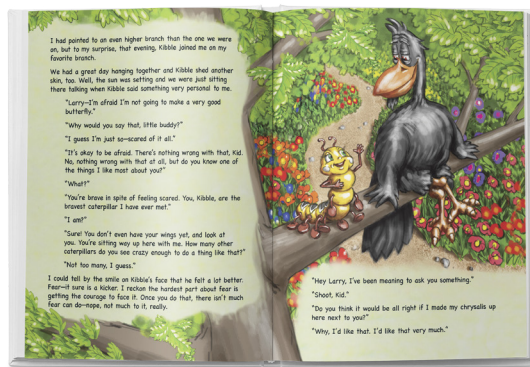
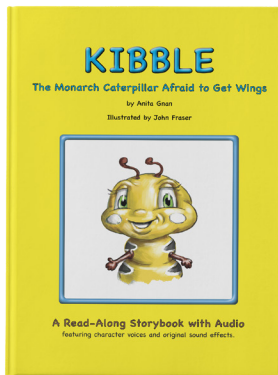


KIBBLE THE BUTTERFLY GETS HIS WINGS IN THIS FUN-FILLED CHILDREN'S STORYBOOK
